

HIGH KELLING PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Virtual Extraordinary Meeting held on 9th February 2020 at 7.40pm via Zoom

Attending: Cllr Gordon Lane (Vice-Chair), Cllr Patrick Kelly, Cllr Duncan Henderson, Cllr Susan Rutherford, Cllr John Mangan and Parish Clerk Gemma Harrison.

No members of the public were present.

Technical Issues were experienced this evening with the Clerk primarily and later the Chairman, finding it difficult to gain access to the meeting. The meeting started late, and the Chairman was not present until right at the end.

1. Administrative

- a) Apologies received from Cllrs unable to attend due to the technical difficulties.
- b) No declaration of interests received.

2. To adjourn the meeting for Public Participation.

- a) No members of the public present.

3.To discuss the proposal to donate £150 towards the Judicial Review costs for opposing the Vanguard decision.

a) Cllr Mangan gave an update on the various wind farm proposals and clearly explained the impact the proposals would have on the parish of High Kelling and the benefit of the ring main. Cllr Mangan talked Cllrs through a short presentation, which is available to be downloaded from the Parish Council website. There has recently been a Judicial Review on the Norfolk Vanguard decision and a crowdfunding site established to help fund the review. The Judicial Review if successful will successfully delay the Vattenfall wind farm which was approved in July last year which would benefit High Kelling residents.

b) Cllr Mangan PROPOSED that High Kelling Parish Council pay £150 towards the Judicial Review fund, this was SECONDED by Cllr Lane and AGREED by all present.

c) Cllr Carter sent his approval by e-mail and later entered the meeting after the vote had taken place and expressed his support.

d) Cllr Mangan to send the clerk details of the fund and the clerk to investigate the best way to pay into the crowd funding appeal, ensuring the money gets to its intended source.

The Meeting ended at 8.13pm
